Talks have been held to deepen democracy and the market economy developing in Mongolia, share the experience of Germany, render support on developing the electoral system of Mongolia and cooperate in sectors of education
defense, society and health with frames of bilateral full partnership relations. Also, we have shared views on bilateral and regional cooperation. German ChancellorAngela Merkel said,"I am very happy with my first visit to Mongolia as German Chancellor Although Mongolia and Germany are located far apart, the countries still strengthen cooperation. We shared views on strengthening the economy and diniocracy and cooperating in in mineral resources and the mining sector.
